- Purchasing and sales of ammunition and supplies necessary for club use.
- Event and competition coordination.
- Advising participants of rules and regulations.
- Enforcing safety rules.
- Keeping accurate financial records.

- Directing club staff towards event management, maintenance and property improvements, target repairs, landscaping, etc.
- Working with contractors for property and equipment repairs and improvements.

- Ability to instruct new members on use of firearms.
- Judge competitions.
- Hiring, training, and termination of club staff.
- Tracking and submitting payroll records.
- Maintaining personnel records and completing annual evaluations.
